This is feedback from 11 participants after our initial three month period of activity. We asked the attendees a series of yes/no/don't know questions, and then asked them to provide some written feedback (on page 2).

The feedback we received was overwhelmingly positive, and shows exactly the impact this program has already made in such a short space of time.

Parents noted that this activity has helped their children make new friends, kept them away from screens, developed their sense of discipline, and learned a new skill, all the while having fun.
