School Walkway

- Parents & carers of the 300+ pupil population use this pathway everyday, sometimes twice a day
- This is the main access way for after school activities, evening events & shows
- The walkway is shady & plain, with no plant or insect life & looks onto the school car park



Proposal

- Introduce densely populated borders with ornamental grasses & hardy perennials
- Scatter small populations of wildflower seeds which will establish over time
- Plant in drifts to mimic natural environment
- Allow insect populations to thrive & diversify, supported by our bug hotels



Bug Hotels



Funding Request - £1000

- Funding is used to purchase established perennials which are planted *en masse* in three different borders
- Each border contains slightly different variety of the purchased plants
- Each border is supplemented with other plants sourced through sustainable means

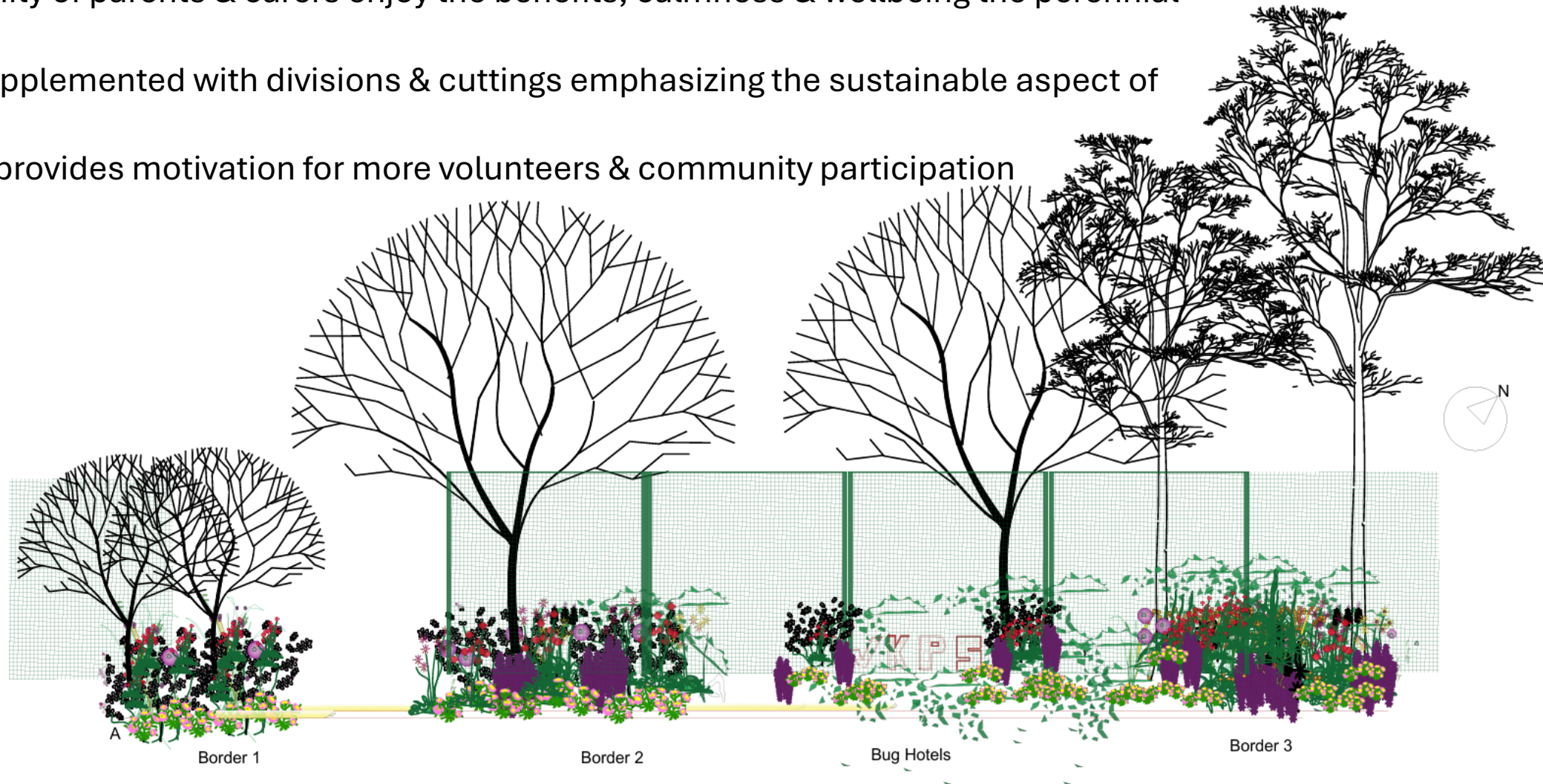

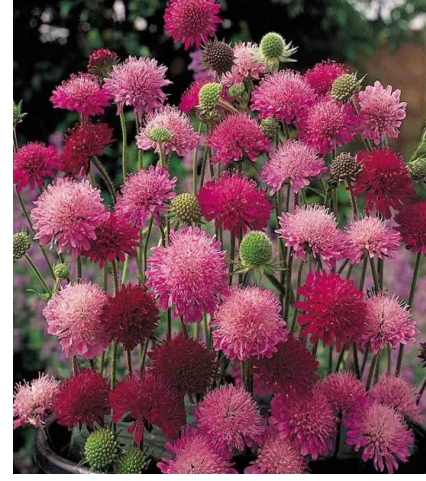
