About Kilwinning Community Events

Kilwinning Community Events is a voluntary group originally set up to hold a firework display in Kilwinning. It has continued to grow in the events it delivers and is most associated with McGavin Park. The primary aims and objectives of Kilwinning Community Events, as set out in our constitution accepted in 2012, are:

- to promote and arrange an annual Firework Festival in the Kilwinning area with associated leisure and recreational events for the community of Kilwinning and North Ayrshire.
- to encourage community involvement and participation.
- to encourage social inclusion and create a greater sense of community in Kilwinning and North Ayrshire and its surrounding communities.
- to advance the education and development of the membership involved in the delivery of the Kilwinning community events and its associated events.

In 2015 consultation began and plans to extensively regenerate McGavin Park were drafted. However, in March 2017 it was announced by the group concerned would not progress with any work would not progress any further - there were several reasons for this.

With Kilwinning Community Events seeing McGavin Park as their 'base' we are really keen to see the park used a lot more by the community. We were asked to look at different needs and options across the large space to allow our events to be more successful which we hope in turn will encourage continued and expanded use of the park. Kilwinning Community Events have worked closely with North Ayrshire Council, who own and maintain the park on behalf of the community, sharing our vision, ideas and plans for the park with them.
